Everything is going here as well as can be expected. I am free to say that the business on the Hand Book is quite good, and the prospects brighten every day. We are now selling at the rate of 500 or 600 a month, and I know I can more than double this by going into the field which I shall do soon.

We had a settlement with R. & H. and notes were given for the account, as was talked of before you left. Instead of the acct. amounting to \$3,000.00 we found it had been brought down to \$2,648.00 so you see we have been doing something in this line. We are now preparing to start a new set of books for this secular book business, separate from Mother's but have not yet opened them. I think things are looking very favorable for this business.
