Jones and Waggoner  
had counterpart  
in Joshua and Caleb

You give us a statement which has come to you purporting to be from the Review and Herald of 1892 or thereabouts concerning Elders Jones and Waggoner having their counterpart in Joshua and Caleb. We have never found any such statement in the E. G. White writings, published or unpublished, and the wording itself leads us to feel that it is not from the pen of Ellen G. White. While there are some references in it which undoubtedly were tied to some things Ellen White wrote, there are other parts of it which sound quite foreign to Ellen White. This is particularly so of the statement that we would "have to go back into the wilderness and there stay forty years." We ask that you do not use this spurious statement, as an E. G. White production.
