Dear Sister,---

I have never heard Mother say that the judgment had begun upon the living, and we do not find any such ~~ix~~ statement in her writings. Some time ago she wrote in one of her articles that the judgment would soon begin upon the living. From this some have concluded that it must have begun by this time. But I do not find that Mother has made such a statement.

I do not think that mother has ever stated with reference to Dr. Kellogg and Elder A. T. Jones that their doom was sealed. Often people have asked Mother if she thought these men would ever come back to the position they formerly occupied in connection with their brethren, and Mother has said that it appeared from what they were doing that it would be very difficult for them to come back. This she expressed as an opinion. I do not think that she has ever said that she had definite knowledge with reference to their future.

It is not wise to draw inferences and conclusions and treat such inferences as though they were Mother's statements, and yet this is often done.
