P.C.T.C. REVISION A progress report was given on the work of the committee revising the Pathfinder Counselors' Training Courses.

ADULT PATHFINDER UNIFORM Discussion: Adult Pathfinder leaders who are not Master Guides wear the suntan uniform (men) or the forest green (women). Those who are Master Guides will, on appropriate occasions, wear the suntan uniform or the Master Guide dress uniform with either the Eisenhower Jacket or the blouse. There is the choice of wearing full insignia or none on the Eisenhower jacket. The Sabbath dress uniform may include white shirt with black tie, belt, socks, shoes, instead of khaki shirt and tie and brown belt, shoes, and socks.

INSIGNIA ON EISENHOWER JACKET VOTED, That we place full sleeve insignia on the Eisenhower jacket of Master Guide uniform. A Master Guide who is not in Pathfinder work would not wear the Pathfinder insignia.

WOMEN'S UNIFORM VOTED, To authorize the Eisenhower jacket as a part of the women's Master Guide uniform.

GIRLS' PATHFINDER UNIFORM VOTED, That we add the pedal-pusher to the official girls' Pathfinder uniform, making a three-piece uniform consisting of forest green waist, skirt, and pedal pusher.

OLDER BOYS' PATHFINDER UNIFORM VOTED, That forest green epaulets may be added to the suntan uniform shirt of the seventh and eighth grade Pathfinder boys.

OLDER GIRLS' PATHFINDER UNIFORM VOTED, That the official Pathfinder girls' uniform for seventh and eighth grade girls may include a white blouse to replace the forest green waist, and a green tuxedo tie for Explorers and gold tuxedo tie for Guides.

MASTER GUIDE NECKERCHIEF VOTED, That we continue with the material now used for Master Guide neckerchiefs.

NECKERCHIEF FOR JMV CLASSES VOTED, That we issue a gold neckerchief for all JMV Classes and that a banded plastic neckerchief loop 1 1/2 inches long and 7/8 inch in diameter be used to distinguish the various classes.
