Dear Brother Maxwell:

We have your letter of March 25 in which you ask about the baptism of Ellen White by her husband, James White, according to Messenger to the Remnant, p. 24. This brief reference is the only reference we have to this rebaptism on the part of Ellen White. We assume that such baptism was on account of the advance step into the Sabbath light.

You are correct in your impression that Ellen White was baptized at the age of twelve into the Methodist church. She does not counsel nor do we find the records of our workers being baptized as various points of light came to them, with the possible exception of the Sabbath truth.

The Ellen G. White counsels on rebaptism have been compiled on pages 372-375 of the book Evangelism.

It's always good to hear from you. I am leaving next Sunday for Germany, where I will spend the next six weeks. May the Lord bless you in your work there.
