S. N. HASKELL--EARLY LIFE

I do not want that you should think from what I have written that in any way I am discouraged or that is my feelings all the time. It is only the result of a feeling that grows out of my situation, etc. You see I was married before I was eighteen years old. And my wife was much as I was in some things and that was we always had our own way. We were so situated we were not dependent and so we had a good team from one to three horses until I sold on account of the Truth. That was after I began to travel. Then I after that when she was able we had one for her. Where she was it was home. I wrote her and received from her a letter each week and sometimes oftener. Each night before I went to sleep I prayed for her, you, and one or two others.
